
DOG-FRIENDLY WALKS

- Enjoy a leisurely stroll along the **Tarka Trail**, a scenic off-road cycle path that runs close to Affinity Devon.
- Explore the picturesque **Westward Ho!** beach, a popular spot for dog walking (please check local dog restrictions).
- Discover the stunning **South West Coast Path**, offering breathtaking views and plenty of opportunities for your dog to sniff out new adventures. The nearest access points are likely to be around Northam Burrows (4.5 miles), Westward Ho! (3.5 miles) or Instow (6 miles).

Other popular routes, along with their approximate distances from Affinity Devon include:

- **Baggy Point:** Approximately 23 miles.
- Crow Point, Braunton Burrows: Approximately 19 miles.
- Heddon's Mouth: Approximately 30 miles.
- Kenwith Valley Nature Reserve: Approximately 3.7 miles.
- Lee Bay to Ilfracombe: Lee Bay is approximately 27 miles, and Ilfracombe is approximately 24 miles.
- Lynmouth to Watersmeet: Lynmouth is approximately 31 miles, and Watersmeet is a location within the Lynmouth area.
- Northam Burrows: Approximately 4.5 miles.
- Morte Point to Bull Point: Mortehoe (near Morte Point) is approximately 26 miles, and Bull Point approximately 28 miles.
- Putsborough to Woolacombe: Putsborough is approximately 21 miles, and Woolacombe is approximately 24 miles.
- Seven Oaks Local Nature Reserve: Approximately 2.6 miles.
- Skern View Dog Field: Approximately 5 miles.
- Torrington Commons: Approximately 8 miles.
- Valley of the Rocks, Lynton: Approximately 31 miles.
- Victoria Park: Approximately 2.5 miles.
- **Wistlandpound:** Approximately 24 miles.
